BOUZY GRAND CRU

BLANC DE NOIRS

This cuvée is the precise expression of the Bouzy terroir through two parcels.

The power of the terroir of these south-facing Pinot Noir vines on the Montagne de Reims combines with the freshness and tension derived from the chalky subsoil.

Cultural practices : vines growing with the respect of nature.
Influenced by ecological methods. Planted in 1988 and 1986.

Assemblage :

- 100 % Pinot Noir – Montagne de Reims. Grand Cru

Vinification :

- Picked up by hand when fully ripen, traditional press.
- Alcoholic fermentation in barrels.
- Malolactic fermentation not made.
- Ageing on fine lees.

Dosage : disgorgment by hand. 2 Gr /l.
