

CHAMPAGNE

Laherte Frères À CHAVOT

Petit Meslier

This forgotten grape is particularly close to our hearts and we decided to replant it, for its strong personality and to preserve the varietal diversity of Champagne. From the crossing of Gouais Blanc and Savagnin, it offers us rare and intense emotions.

Cultural practices : vines growing with the respect of nature. Influenced by ecological methods. Young vines planted in 2014 and 2018.

Blend :

- 100% Petit Meslier. Middle of hills. Clay-silty soils aver 1,5 meters then soft chalk.
- Blend of several harvest. Around 40% of reserve wines.

Vinification :

- Picked up by hand at full maturity.
- traditional press and directly put into the barrels by gravity.
- Alcoholic fermentation in barrels with a few batonnages.
- Malolactic fermentation made.
- Ageing on lees during 6 months.

Dosage : disgorgment by hand. 2 gr/L.
